The two horse team will:

plow 1½ to 2 acres per day,
 disc 10 acres per day,
 harrow 10 to 12 acres per day,
 drill 6 to 10 acres per day,
 plant 8 acres per day,
 cultivate 8 acres per day,
 mow 8 acres per day,
 rake 16 acres per day,
 or do wagon work 25 miles per day.

Three horses on a farm will:

plow 3 acres per day,
 disc 15 acres per day,
 harrow 15 to 17 acres per day,
 drill 12 to 15 acres per day,
 or cultivate (with 2 on one cultivator and
 1 on another) 12 acres per day.

Four horses on a farm will:

plow 4 acres per day,
 disc 20 acres per day,
 harrow 17 to 20 acres per day,
 drill 20 acres per day,
 plant (with 2 planters, or doubled)
 16 acres per day,
 cultivate 16 acres per day,
 mow (with 2 teams) 16 acres per day,
 or rake (with 2 teams) 32 acres per
 day.

Six horses on a farm will:

plow 6 acres per day,
 disc 30 acres per day,
 harrow 30 acres per day,
 drill 30 acres per day,
 plant (3 teams) 24 acres per day,
 cultivate (3 teams) 24 acres per day,
 mow (3 teams) 24 acres per day,
 or rake (3 teams) 48 acres per day.
